Research activities since 2009

- Large scale urban perinatal and child health development program in the Rotterdam region; combining research and care innovation in Prenatal Medicine, Clinical Epidemiology, Public Health (in particular Child Health), Health Economics, Psychometrics. Currently focussing on preventive programs.
- National projects on Perinatal Epidemiology, Maternity Care Services, Women's Psychosocial and Mental Health, routine antenatal screening tools. Inequality research (etiological, interventions). Quality management (external: benchmarking, internal: PDCA).
- Indicators for performance in perinatal care and early youth health care. Both instrument development and implementation with the involvement of clients/patients.
- Questionnaire development, psychometrics currently focussing on PROMs to be used beyond standard economic purposes: individualized treatment decisions, surveillance of treatment, quality of provider/benchmarking.
- Projects for the EuroQol foundation (burden of disease, use of EuroQol for inequity measures, personalized choices using EuroQol information, design and analysis methods for valuation studies.
